

Do you work with older people living in care homes who experience falls?

Care home staff, paramedics and healthcare staff across England are invited to take part in a short interview as part of a research study to develop principles for providing care immediately after an older person falls in a care home (known as post-falls management). This research is sponsored (led) by Nottingham University Hospitals NHS Trust.

We would like to hear experiences and opinions of care home staff, and health care staff working in primary, community, emergency and acute setting to inform the choice of key post-falls management principles. The interview will be conducted by telephone or online, according to your preference. The interview is estimated to take no more than 60 minutes to complete.
